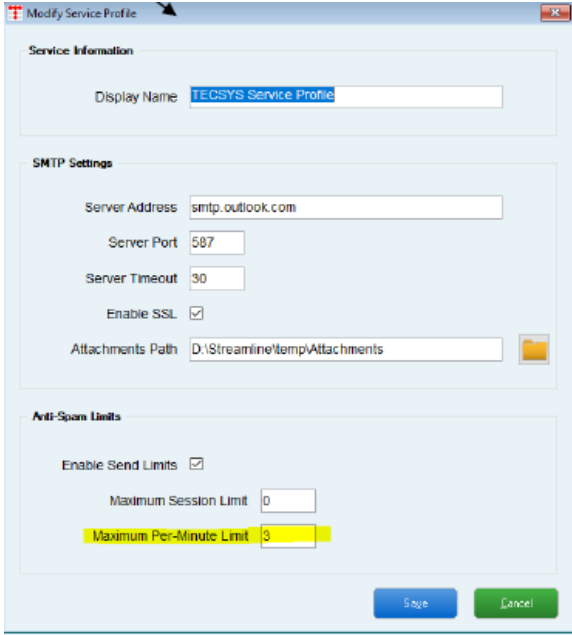
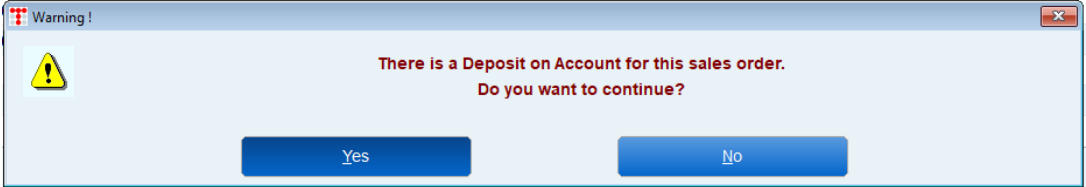

This enhancement has been extended to the following programs: - E-Commerce Admin Accounts > E-Commerce Administrator password. - Sales Order Processing > Remote Signature Capture Users > User password

2.	2020.1	SMTP Email Setup Anti-Spam Limit change Installation > SMTP Email Setup > Service Profiles In the anti-spam section on the New/Modify Service Profile screen, the Maximum Hourly Limit field has been changed to Maximum Per-Minute Limit. This field represents the frequency with which emails can be sent per minute.

3.	2020.1	Warning for Deposits on Account A new warning message has been added to Order Entry if an attempt is made to close or cancel an order that has a deposit on account. Here is the message that displays:  If you select Yes, the system will continue to cancel/close the order.

4.	2020.1.0	Shopping Cart Enhancements Previously, the shopping cart could only be closed by clicking the Shopping Cart icon from an open shopping cart. The shopping cart will now automatically close when you click anywhere outside of the shopping cart details page. Note: When you remove an item from the shopping cart using the Remove button, the system no longer prompts you to confirm this action. Responding to a confirmation request will force you to navigate off of the shopping cart thereby auto-closing the cart.

5.	2020.1.0	WMS Certification WMS versions 9.5x and 9.6x have been certified with Streamline version 2020.1. The WMS Warehouse Setup program includes all certified WMS versions in the WMS Version drop list.

6.	2020.1.0 2019.4.0	Standard Messages for Production Tickets Most of the forms in Streamline are designed to include standard messaging that appears above the footer of the final page on the printed form and additional standard messaging that appears in the email's <i>Subject</i> and <i>Body</i> when these forms are emailed. These standard messages are maintained from the program launched by clicking the <i>Std Messages</i> button in <i>Company Setup > Company Info</i>. Modifications were made to assign Production Tickets their own standard messages rather than using the standard messages for Purchase Orders.
